As you may all know, only one of the questions we had a position on was defeated, SQ 744. Keep an eye on the Tulsa County filed case against SQ's 746 and 751. It will be renewed per the agreement that was reached on September 18, 2010, prior to the election. The plaintiffs reserved the right to renew the case if the questions were approved.

Additionally, keep an eye out for a case to be filed on Constitutional grounds regarding the passage of SQ 755, the Sharia law question. CAIR reported to KFOR on November 3, 2010 (see KFOR.com) that they have an interested individual who will be filing the suit.

Be a good citizen and encourage folks to clean up their campaign signs. Nothing worse than seeing a campaign sign covered in snow around the Holidays, ruining the landscape.
